Dear NTAC Swimmer,

The Toronto Lands Corporation and Toronto District School Board continue to perform repairs to our school pools. The Lawrence Park Collegiate Institute pool is included in the group of pools slated to undergo repairs and remain open for a further 8 years. Repairs to the pool at Lawrence Park are of the same type as the Glenview pool has recently undergone.

We have now received confirmation that the Lawrence Park pool will be closed this coming September to December 2010.

Impacts to our 2010/11 program

After some investigation and consideration of alternatives, we believe there may be a limited period of pool time available at Forest Hill Collegiate Institute on Thursday evenings. We have submitted a request to the Toronto District School Board Permit Office. Unfortunately they are unable to tell us at this time whether our request will be granted. We expect to hear from them in mid-July. It is our hope that we will be successful in securing the Forest Hill pool.

We plan to relocate our Thursday evening adult masters class to the Forest Hill pool for the period that the Lawrence Park pool will be undergoing repairs. We will contact all NTAC Thursday adult masters swimmers as soon as we have heard any news.

Our 'intro to synchro' class will be relocating to the Glenview pool for the entire 2010-11 swimming season.

The Tuesday Bronze Medallion course traditionally offered at the Lawrence Park pool, will relocate to the Glenview pool for the fall term only.

Starting in January 2011, we will be offering a new Lifesaving Prep course geared to all teens who have started on the journey toward becoming full-fledged instructors and lifeguards. The focus of the class will be stroke perfection, lifesaving skills and developing endurance. This course will replace our former competitive class. More detailed information will be posted to our internet site in the coming weeks.

We thank you for your patience and your continued support of our club at this time and into the future, and we look forward to an improved Lawrence Park pool facility in the new year.
